Dear all,

Next Sunday evening St. John's is going to start running *The Grace Course* in two parts, first during July and the rest in September. The course describes the Christian life in Biblical

and clear ways that enable us to grow deeper in our appreciation of what Jesus has done for us on the cross and gain confidence in God's word and Spirit in living the life we've been given. Topics include being free, being innocent, being courageous, being unashamed and more.
