Parish Child Protection Policy Statement ; Parish of Southbourne with West Thorney.

The following was agreed at the PCC meeting held on 24th May 2018

As members of this PCC, we are concerned to safeguard, care and nurture of all our members, particularly the children and young people.

- We recognise that our work with children and young people is the responsibility of the whole church community.
- We are committed to implementing the House of Bishops' Child Protection Policy "Protecting All God's Children 2010" and the Diocesan procedures, which are based on the Children Act, and the Government guidance "Working Together To safeguard Children" both published in 2013
- We will carefully select and train ordained and lay ministers: volunteers and paid workers with children and young people using the Disclosing and Barring Service, amongst other tools, to check the background of each person.
- We will respond, without delay, to every complaint made that a child or young person, for whom we are responsible, may have been harmed.
- We will co-operate fully with statutory agencies during any investigation concerning a member of the church community.
- We will seek to offer informed pastoral care to any child or children, young person or adult who has suffered abuse.
- We will care for and supervise any member of the church community known to have offended against a child.
- We will review this policy annually and as part of this process will ensure that all our procedures, particularly in relation to the Disclosing and Barring Service, are up to date.
