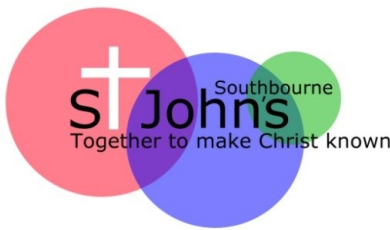
**Step Together is the name for our new Junior Church/Sunday School for Sunday Mornings.** It will consist

**If you play an instrument and would like to play in the All Age Service on the 1st Sunday of each month Kim Carter would like to hear from you.**

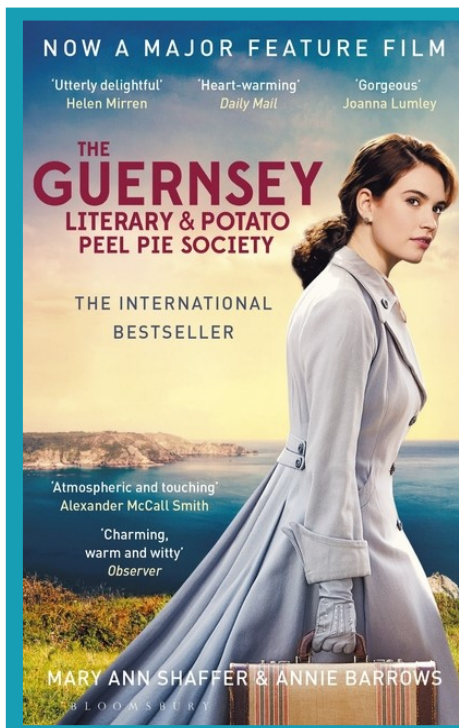
