Look out for a new printing of "Day by Day, which was originally designed in 1977. It has been redesigned for a global audience, with illustrations commissioned especially for the booklet. As the COVID crisis continues many need God's presence, and ask for his guidance and protection

"Consider the wildflowers" (flourishing in the chaos)

This is a booklet written by women from a charity called Azalea who support women from sexual exploitation. It also is aimed at people with drug problems, people living on the streets, modern day slavery, or people living in fear of domestic abuse. It reads very well though to anyone who just feels their life is in chaos, and doesn't know who to turn too.
