ST. JOHN'S CHURCH FAMILY NEWS PETER SPRECKLEY'S BOOK

A Life Full of Surprises.


Most people have been taken at some time in their lives by surprise by unexpected events. In the context of my faith life, I think I must have had more than my fair share. The latest was in February last year when I felt I had been commissioned by the Lord to write a book, yet I was just a retired solicitor heading into my eighties, with no academic training, and had never in my wildest dreams thought of writing a book. Happily, the commission was validated in several ways.

The book was published last month under the challenging title of "A Case of Daylight Robbery, What My Church did not teach me."

My faith life must have started when I was christened in 1939 and continued in school chapels, confirmation, and parish churches until in 1984 I discovered that I was not yet a Christian, (second surprise!). The first one was when God challenged me when one day I was mowing the grass in the churchyard next door to our house.

The book recounts in the context of my spiritual journey some foundational scriptures which I discovered for the first time, and which are critical to our understanding our identity in Christ, which in turn led to my being transformed from a lukewarm church-goer to a witness for the gospel both in this country and abroad, as the words of the bible became alive in my experience.

In the writing I have learned so much which I had not previously understood of God's limitless provision for us through the new covenant, to live the life Jesus calls us to live, for which he has freely equipped us. I dare to believe that any seeker of the truth will find some encouraging fresh understanding from what the Lord has caused me to share. [Peter will be sharing more at the 10am service].


