We have received details from All Souls Music of their live concert broadcast which you can view by clicking on the above link.

Chichester Cathedral is delighted to share *Carols from Chichester Cathedral* – a 50 minute Carol Service filmed with the Cathedral's famous Choir, under the direction of Organist and Master of the Choristers Charles Harrison and with organ accompaniment from Tim Ravalde.

Music is central to celebrations for Advent and Christmas, and to enable this to continue in a year when churches can only welcome very limited numbers of visitors in person, *Carols from Chichester Cathedral* allows the people of Sussex and beyond to take part in this tradition from the comfort of their own homes.

The service has subtitles and has been especially written and recorded for online congregations, telling the Christmas story with a selection of carols. Bible readings and poetry can also be found in the service, read by individuals representing local organisations and charities, including Stonepillow, Goodwood Farm, BBC Radio Sussex, Midwives from the Western Sussex Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust and from the Patron of the Cathedral's Festival of Flowers, Hugh Bonneville.

### The Very Reverend Stephen Waine, Dean of Chichester, said:

"On behalf of all of us at Chichester Cathedral, we invite you to join us for this very special service for 2020. Sing along with the Cathedral Choir and experience the comfort and joy that Christmas brings as we celebrate the birth of our Saviour, Jesus Christ."

As well as regular services, special services for Advent and Christmas at the Cathedral will also be live-streamed including the Cathedral Carol Service on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> December; First Evensong of Christmas on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> December; Midnight Mass on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> December and the Christmas Day Eucharist on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> December. The Cathedral's plans for Advent and Christmas invite everyone to come together in celebration, under the banner of *Drop Down, Ye Heavens* – referring to the ancient Advent antiphon *Rorate caeli*: 'Drop down ye heavens, and let the skies pour down righteousness'.

*Carols from Chichester Cathedral* is free to view via the Cathedral's website, however donations are most welcome. The Cathedral has launched a fundraising initiative to raise its running costs through the 12 days of Christmas. It costs £3,000 a day to protect our sacred heritage, so they are aiming to raise £36,000 this festive season.
