Christian Aid Envelopes 9th-16th May 2021

As Christian Aid representative for St. John's, I suggest that we use the 'DELIVER ONLY CHRISTIAN AID ENVELOPES' that will NOT be needed to be collected on a return visit. I feel this option will keep our volunteers and householders much safer during the Corona Virus pandemic.

There will be details with the envelopes of how to give online via the e-envelope, like last year. Those who wish to give a cash donation will be able to post their envelope through the letter box at the back of the church centre. A full risk assessment has been drawn up, subject to the approval of Matt and the PCC.

I intend to target only about 12 roads in the parish that have given good returns in the past. However, you are most welcome to deliver envelopes in your own street, if you could let me know please.

So contact me as soon as possible before 20th April if you are able to deliver Christian envelopes this year and let me know what roads you would like to cover, so I can order enough resources in time. Christian Aid week is 9th -16th May, so it is less than a month away. Remember it is deliver only, with no requirement to go back to knock and collect, due to Covid restrictions.
