ST. JOHN'S FAMILY NEWS - SUE FALLON'S TRIP TO NEPAL



I have just returned from a fantastic trip to Nepal where I spent an amazing 8 days trekking and a fun few days sightseeing.

The trip was planned almost a year ago with the goal to reach Annapurna Base Camp (4130 meters) There was never a day where we walked either all up or all down. Each day seemed to involve going from high up one side of the valley to high up on the other side.

Looking at the itinerary you could be fooled into thinking we weren't going to be doing much on one of the days as we were to sleep at 2,500 meters one night and 2,700 meters the next. What they hadn't put was that we needed to go down to 1,830 meters to cross the valley!

The weather was interesting as we experienced everything from walking in shorts and t-shirts to wearing every thermal thing we owned, beautiful sunshine, getting soaked, being pelted with hail, and walking through snow, it was brilliant. We had heard from other trekkers that they made it to the base camp but were met with 12cm of fresh snow and near white out conditions, they couldn't see anything, this was just 2 days before we were due to get there! That was not to be the case for us, we had stunning views all the way up, it was breath taking.

I was a bit slower than most of the group and consequently there was only myself and a porter on the path for quite a while, what a blessing as God's creation unfolded around us and the peace and beauty was spectacular, a great opportunity for reflection.

We happened to be getting to the base camp May 6th and so had our own little coronation celebration. That day was the longest as we went from 3,700 meters at 4:45am to get to base camp at 4,130 meters for sunrise and arrived at 3:00pm at 2,500 meters where we would sleep for the night. It was all worth it!
