Church Together BBQ - it was a brilliant day. Enjoyed by everyone.

Hello everyone, A Reflective Assembly:

This assembly has been held annually now for the last three years. Instead of me visiting the school, the 60 or so Year 6 students, along with their teachers and teachers assistants come and visit the church.

The assembly has a 'light' and 'reflective' service feel to it. I lit a candle and explained, "That as Christians, we light a candle to remind us that we believe Jesus is with us, right now, and to remember that He is the light of the world". I then led the students in a short opening prayer, before sharing a short, interactive talk and creative Bible reading.

I then led the students in a creative prayer. I gave them two cardboard cut outs of feet and asked them to think of things that they were looking forward to at Secondary school. I then asked them to write on the other foot how they were feeling about stepping forward to high school in order to for them to stop for a moment to reflect on how they are feeling.

I then asked the students to bring their feet to the front of the platform and to create a line from the platform to out of the church to show that we are not stepping forward alone, but stepping forward together.

Finally, I shared Philippians 4:6 with the students which says:

6 Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.
