## **PCC UPDATE**

Here are highlights of the March PCC meeting, the first chaired by our new vicar, Tom Robson. The full minutes are available via the Church Office.

Tom was encouraged by the number of people who attended the Love Southbourne meeting on Sunday and the enthusiasm shown. Initial ideas include distributing hot cross buns on Good Friday, several events planned for the Coronation weekend, running a BBQ at the Sussex Day fete, events in Christian Aid week, and healing and memorial services. Tom would like to convene a small group to plan events through the year.

Tom is re-introducing mid-week Communion, 9.30am on term-time Wednesdays.

He's also considering a monthly evening Communion service, and an "inperson" prayer meeting in addition to the online prayer meetings.

He also wants to start an enquirers' evening at the Vicarage for non and very new Christians.'

He took the opportunity to discuss the role of the PCC, which should be to develop a vision for kingdom growth, whereas managing day-to-day practicalities can be devolved to subgroups involving those with expertise in particular subjects. This will also relieve the churchwardens of some of their workload.

Richard and Kim reported on a busy month with Families and Youth, and hope to take a group of young people to MayCamp in May half-term.

Julie Fair has completed the risk assessments and lots of other preparation for Christian Aid week.

Ian presented the financial accounts for the year, prior to the APCM: well done Ian!

Tim is working hard to bring the church up to speed with current fire regulations: there will be fire practices in the next few months!

We discussed the upcoming APCM: there will be elections for a churchwarden, 4 Deanery Synod members and 2 PCC members. Please pray about these important posts and seek to nominate the people the Lord wants in these roles. Forms will be available at the back of church and from the Office after Easter.

There is likely to be an Awayday for the new PCC on June 16th.
