ASSISTED SUICIDE DEBATE

Assisted suicide debate

Please consider responding to the Government inquiry about assisted suicide (assisted dying/euthanasia). None of us wants to see anyone suffering, but the response should be better access to good palliative care, not asking doctors to help kill patients. As Christians, we should be protecting the weakest and most vulnerable in our society and none of the proposed safeguards has managed to do this in any country where assisted suicide has been legalised.


