What Sort of Pond are you?

As I was praying on the morning of the 8-8 day of prayer, I had this picture which I believe is from God:

I saw a healthy pond with lifegiving water flowing into and out of it, it was vibrant and full of life and growth, as the water flowed out of it, it carried some of that life with it.

I then saw a pond with no water flowing in or out of it, it was stagnant and dead, there was no life in it.

The next pond had life giving water flowing into it but not out of it, it had nowhere to go, so it just evaporated, the life was restricted and could not be passed on.

The next pond had water flowing into it and out of it but the water flowing out of it had a narrow outlet which restricted the amount of lifegiving water that flowed out of it.

Again, I saw the healthy pond with a similar amount of water flowing out of it as into it. I was reminded of the abundance of life in it and how that life and water flowed out of it and onwards, watering the land and bringing life to other places.

I believe God is saying that we are like those ponds, we need the Holy Spirit flowing into and out of us, without it our faith can be stagnant or lifeless.

So, the question for each of us is which type of pond are you and which one do you want to be?
