If you would like to get involved in 4 o'clock church, we're looking for welcomers or stewards, and volunteers to organise tea coffee before the service. See Kim






















COFFEE CONNECT

PCC UPDATE

February 2022

Please continue to pray for the PCC and all the church's activities. Here are highlights from the February PCC meeting. The full minutes are always available via the Church Office.

The Faculties (Diocese permission) for the church renovations have been granted, thanks to the hard work of those who submitted all the paperwork. Everyone was very excited to see the AV screen back in church on Sunday, and we are discussing how to upgrade this. There should be information about the options appearing in the Weekly News.

Julie Fair submitted an ambitious list of events for Christian Aid week, May 15-22, please get in touch with her if you can volunteer in any way.

Richard would like to take the Youth Group to Diocesan May Camp.

We fund a significant mission effort locally, including through our Families work, Love Southbourne and via our Parish Share to the Diocese, but we are so grateful to God and the congregation for their financial generosity, which means we have been able to increase our Mission Giving to charities with strong links to St John's, and offer our staff a pay rise this year.

Preparation for A Passion for Life continues, with very useful videos on a Sunday morning. Matt said we hoped to invite Gavin Calver to engage in a Question and Answer session at Easter. Matt has plans for a Lent Course and a marriage course.

There has been a request to use the Centre for a new singing group for people with dementia. This was agreed in principle. We discussed how Golly's work leading "Singing for Fun" could be more formally recognised.

The Eco group are planning a Work Party in the church grounds on Saturday March 19th at 9.30 to make progress on a wildflower garden. Please come and bring garden tools.

Tim has been liaising with the Parish Council about the War Memorial: it is now with them as they have access to funding.

Matt commented that the Vicarage needs some TLC, this may be the responsibility of the Diocese.

We do not currently have a representative from St Nicholas on the PCC.
