If you would like to get involved in 4 o'clock church, we're looking for welcomers or stewards, and volunteers to organise tea coffee before the service. See Kim
























Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of Lent, is March 2nd.

There will be a short service of HC with ashing at 1130 in St John's"




EASTER

PCC UPDATE JANUARY 2022

Please continue to pray for the PCC and all the church's activities. Here is a brief summary from the January PCC meeting. The full minutes are always available via the Church Office.

The church renovations are almost complete, with electrical and woodwork nearly finished. There was discussion about audio-visual equipment, including the positioning of screens. The cost so far has been about £50,000. Despite this the church finances are fairly healthy, many thanks for everyone's regular and sacrificial giving to the work of the church.

The Centre lift needs replacing. We are applying for a grant from Chichester District Council to help with the cost, which will be about £20,000 in all. CDC make their funding decisions in April. In the meantime we will try to hold meetings downstairs so they are accessible.

The Youth Work budget was increased from £1800 to £4000 for this year. This reflects the huge increase in the families attending St John's, especially the Family Service, but also Tots, Friday Fellowship, SYG (Youth) etc.

The PCC also agreed that Richard should apply to the Diocese for permission to preach.

Coffee Connect plans to reopen 1st March.

The Eco group has been focussing on making the church grounds more wildlife friendly, with a work party planned once the weather improves to increase the wild flower area, plant bee-friendly flowers, and build new compost bins.

There have been discussions with the Parish Council about redesigning the War Memorial site. For details of the plans please talk to Tim Marsden.

Unfortunately, Rupert Lucas has had to step down as our St Nicholas representative. We thank him for all his hard work.

A Passion for Life training is continuing on Sunday mornings, with a really helpful series of videos. We hope these will lead to some events being held around Easter.
