UPDATE ON THE CHURCH

An Interim Faculty has been issued for some of the works – stone and timber repairs and the new carpet. A Full Faculty is needed for the Electrical works, (needed as the wiring is about 50 years old, and needs updating along with new data cabling, lighting and possibly heating).

Matt, Tim, Jon and Jane meet last night to discuss all the works needed for Matt to meet with the Architect Julian of Jane Jones Warner, to prepare all the paper work needed for the 2 Faculties.

We can soon start work on the stone and masonry repairs to the arch, and the sanding and oiling of the altar steps and handrail. We are also going to add an oak handrail to each side of the steps to help with access. The contractors will be contacted to establish a date when they can start work.

The BIG item that needs addressing before the carpet can be replaced is the electrical/lighting/heating issue. The existing installation is over 50 years old and is no long fit for purpose. The proposal is to remove carefully what is there, add new ducting all around the church walls (which means the floor needs to be dug up for ducting where there is a door in the way for the wiring to be installed), to give a continuous circuit. (Hence the carpet will be the last thing that is done).


The ducting will carry new wiring and data cabling to meet our needs. This will also involve new lighting and hopefully heating to the church (depending on the cost), to make it a more usable space and hopefully warmer!!

Please understand that the delay has been with Church house getting the Faculties, and we are now proceeding carefully with the final details on the electrical design and installation so that we get it right. Looking to future proof the church and how we use the space for the benefit of the congregation and the community it serves.
