

ARCHBISHOP'S VISIT



ECO NEWS

Home Composting. More useful information.

1. Items NOT to include. Meat or dairy products, cooked food, cat litter.

Tea leaves are good but bags are not as they may contain small amounts of plastic.

Oak leaves as they don't break down quickly. Perennial weeds such as ground elder or bindweed.

- 2. Keep a suitable caddy/container handy in the kitchen for vegetable peelings, etc.
- 3. To accelerate the compost, you can buy pellets or worm friendly pouches.
- 4. Put dead leaves in a black bag to break down over the winter.
- 5. Alternate layers of "green" and "brown" items. Turn heap regularly to aerate




STREET PRAYERS <u>CLICK HERE</u>
