

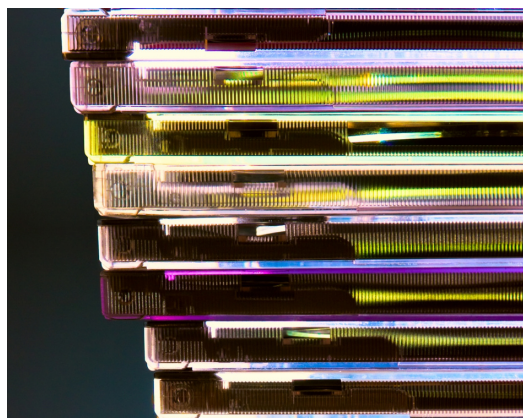

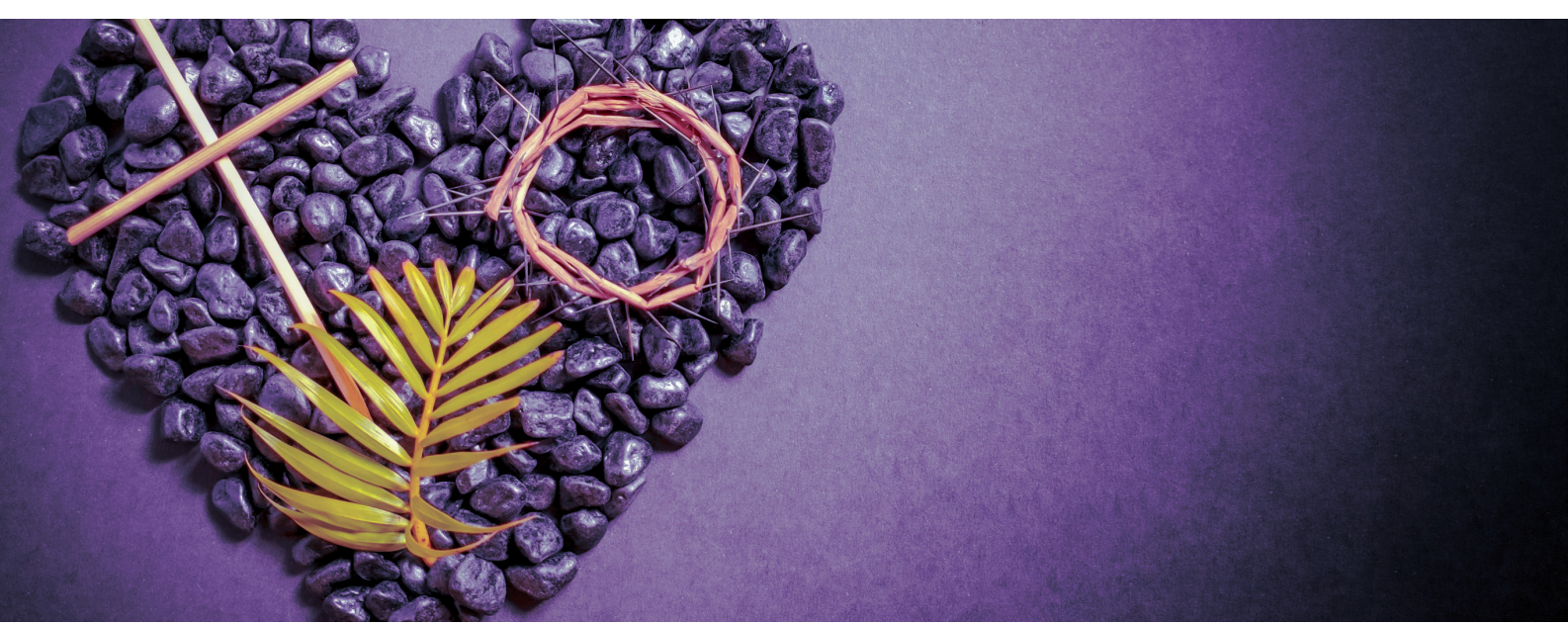
Here is a brief introduction from the author of our Lent series, Matthew L Kelley. He is an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church based in Louisville, Kentucky:

PRAYERS

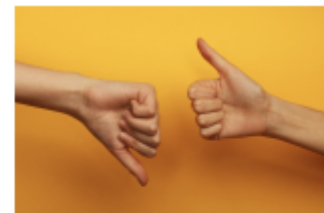
We use creative ways to engage with God in prayer, sometimes moving around the room or using objects to guide us.

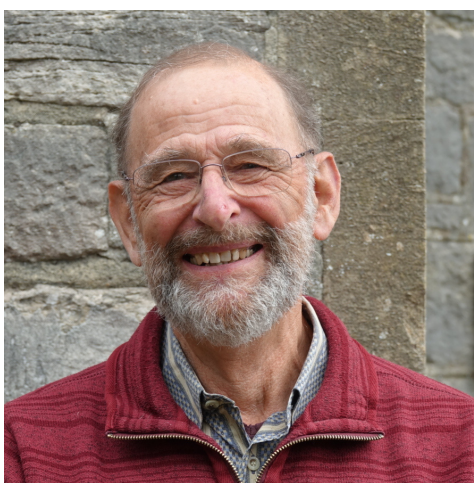
